



Advancement of teams competing in a division comprised of 7 teams:

In a 7 team group:

- Teams in the “A” group play within their division only, comprised of 3 teams.
- Teams in the “B” AND “C” group will play each team in their respective group AND a cross over game, because there are only 2 teams in the “B” and “C” groups. Cross over games are countable toward points and standings to determine a group winner and WILDCARD.
- The semi final match ups will be
 - “A” group winner vs “Wildcard” and;
 - “B” group Winner vs “C” group winner, unless the “Wildcard” comes out of “A” group, then the semi final match ups would be:
 - “A” group winner vs “B” group winner and;
 - “C” group winner vs “Wildcard”

Those games played on Saturday determine the winner of the division. The winners of each division automatically advance to a semi final on Sunday.

The 2nd and 3rd place teams in all divisions are determined by the win / loss record from Saturday’s games. (examples: The 2nd place team from Saturday’s games in the A division will play as the “A2” team in the Sunday game. The 2nd place team in B division will play as the B2 team in the Sunday game and the 2nd place team in the C division will play as the C2 team in the Sunday game).

The third game for the team determined to be the division winner, based on Saturday’s results will advance to the semi-final. Therefore, the most number of games that a Saturday division winner advancing to the final will play is four. For those teams not winning a division will get three games, the 3rd one being played Sunday morning. The WILDCARD team has the potential of playing five games if it advances to the final.

The games scheduled for Sunday are to determine which team wins the WILDCARD position.

There is a possibility, based on total points and the tie breaker procedures, that penalty kicks to determine the WILDCARD position may be necessary.
